



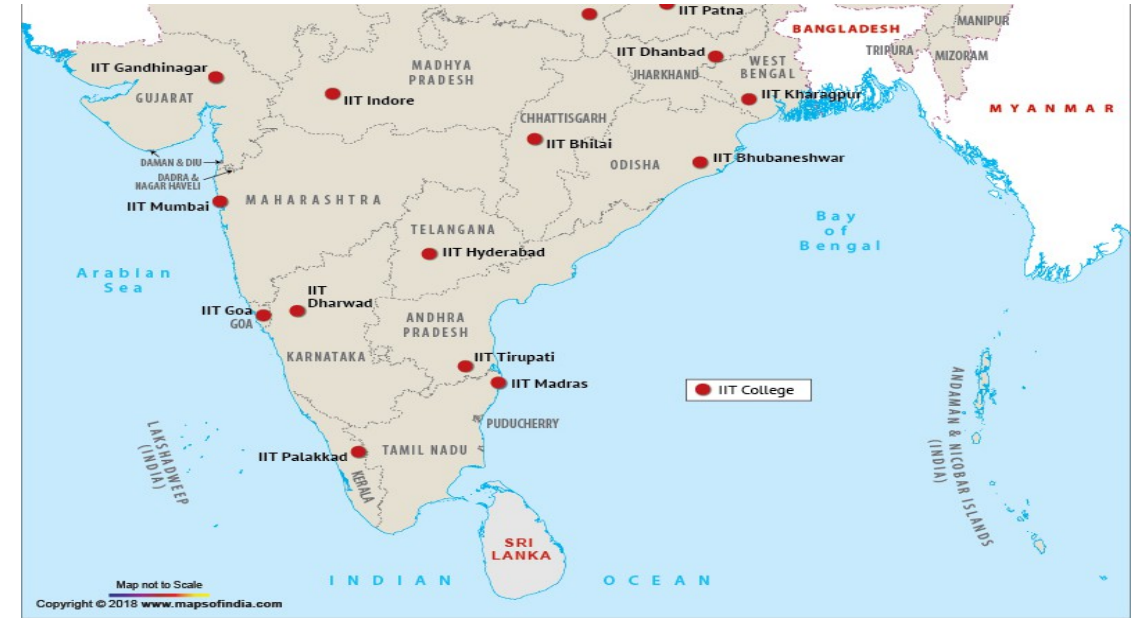

 - Progression: Advancement to PhD contingent on successful completion of MA requirements
- MA by Research (MRes)
 - Launched: 2022
 - Specialization Options (from 2nd year): Sociology; Linguistics, Literature and Performance; Human Sciences
 - Flexibility: Option to pursue
